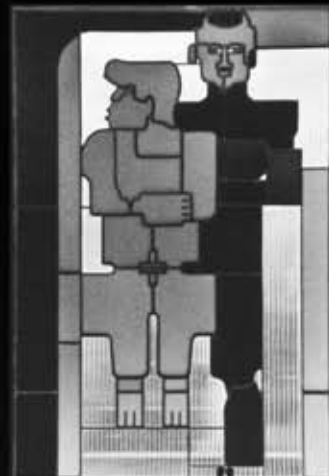


HARRIET HYAMS:

About the Artist & Exhibition

Harriet Hyams is known nationally for her exquisite architectural stained glass installations at residential, corporate, educational and religious sites. Her early work is distinguished by strong abstract expressionist elements, a concept carried through in her stone, wood and metal sculptures of the period. Her *Glas Architectur* panels are considered classics of their genre and she has received critical acclaim and notice for her artistic achievements and experimentation with the form in leading art and architectural journals. Currently her work is more strongly graphic and representational. For this exhibition, Ms. Hyams has created several new glass murals and will exhibit her earlier glass panels, sculpture and new drawings. A slide exhibition of her architectural commissions at their sites will be shown throughout the exhibit.

DIRECTIONS

Route 59 coming from Nyack: Exit on right for Route 303 South. Right onto Route 303 South. Go underneath one overpass and make immediate right onto Route 59 East. Make next right onto service road and then a left turn onto South Greenbush Road. The Center is two-tenths of a mile down the road, on the left.

From Palisades Parkway: Exit #8E onto Route 59 East. Proceed east about 1 mile to Route 303 North Exit. Before reaching 303, make a left onto South Greenbush Road. The Center is two-tenths of a mile down the road, on the left.

From Westchester and New Jersey: Take New York State Thruway to Exit #12. Right at end of ramp onto Route 303 South. Proceed about ¼ mile underneath one overpass and then make immediate right onto Route 59 East. Make next right onto service road and then a left onto South Greenbush Road. The Center is two-tenths of a mile down the road, on the left.
